HEARING/READING OF OBJECTIONS

Mayor Naish noted that there were no written objections submitted for this meeting. When asking if there were any comments or objections from the public present, Pat Mann spoke to Council relating several points for consideration and then submitted his points in writing. Lee Sochasky also spoke to Council adding her comments suggesting that the proposed by-law might be less detailed, stating that simpler might be more effective. She also suggested that the by-law contain schedules to allow greater flexibility such that a by-law amendment could take place more timely from a schedule rather than a full by-law amendment process of three readings. She noted that in the new by-law the Planning Advisory Committee has been omitted from the Committee structure.
