#### Finance and Administration Committee

It was moved by Councillor McNabb, seconded by Councillor Myers and carried that Council approve a grant in the amount of \$1500.00 for the NB Senior's Citizens Federation Inc. 2009 AGM to be held in the Town of St. Andrews in October at the W.C. O'Neill Arena Complex, with funds to come from Civic Promotions.

It was moved by Councillor McNabb, seconded by Deputy Mayor Castell and carried that Council authorize the CAO of the Town of St. Andrews to release a Request for Proposal (RFP) to the public for the continued development of the Champlain Sub-Division lands owned by the Town of St. Andrews.

It was moved by Councillor McNabb, seconded by Councillor Myers and carried that, as per the Provincial Act regulating BIA's, Council instructs Staff to publish a notice at least once weekly for two weeks in a newspaper having general circulation within the municipality disclosing its intention to approve the BIA Budget, a levy of 0.20c /\$100.00 of assessment needed to implement the budget and the period during which objections may be made.

It was moved by Councillor McNabb, seconded by Councillor Bishop and carried that Council approve a grant in the amount of \$200.00 for the By The Sea Garden Club for the hosting of the Charlotte County Blooms seminar at the NBCC on May 2, 2009, with funds to come from Civic Promotions.

It was moved by Councillor McNabb, seconded by Councilor Myers and carried that Council approve a grant in the amount of \$300.00 for the NBCC Student Representative Council for their NBCC St. Andrews Campus Winter Carnival, with funds to come from Assistance Grants. It was moved by Councilor McNabb, seconded by Councillor Myers and carried that the Economic Development Funding line item of \$79,395.00, as identified in the 2009 Draft Budget be allocated as follows:

- Charlotte Coastal Region Tourism Association: \$14,000.00-comprised of \$7000.00 for the Travel Planner, \$4000.00 for the Charlotte County Visitor information Centre (VIC) and \$3000.00 for operations
- St. Andrews Chamber of Commerce: \$65,395.00

These funds are to be allocated on a quarterly basis.
