Town Managers Report

It was moved by Councillor Golding, seconded by Councillor Sochasky and carried that Council approve an application for a Noise Exemption to Noise Control Bylaw 06-04 for a wedding to be held at 332 Brandy Cove Road on August 2, 2014 from 8:00 PM to 1:00 AM and suggests as a courtesy that the applicant notify the adjacent neighbours of the event.

It was moved by Councillor Golding, seconded by Councillor Sochasky and carried that Council approve an application for a Noise Exemption to the Noise Control Bylaw 06-04 for a wedding to be held at 220 King Street, Kingsbrae Garden on August 2, 2014 from 5:30 PM to 1:00 AM and suggests as a courtesy that the applicant notify Kingsbrae Arms of the event.

It was moved by Councillor Golding, seconded by Councillor Sockasky and carried that Council **rescind** the motion of June 2, 2014 that reads, "*It was moved by Councillor Bishop, seconded by Councillor Naish and carried that Council support the comprehensive study of the impact of the St. Andrews Farmers' Market extended hours on local business and Council affirms the continuation of the Market hours until 1:00PM but will approve the extension of the Market operation until 2PM for the month of August to enable a fair study comparison of the Market impact on local business.*"
