CONSIDERATION OF BY-LAWS AND MOTIONS

Hear Objections to By-Law #18-01, Being a By-Law to Regulate Vehicular Traffic in the Town of Saint Andrews

The Town has received several requests for additional wheelchair accessible parking spots along Water Street. One is located on King Street in front of the side entrance to Cockburn's Drug Store. The second request was for a wheelchair accessible parking spot on Water Street in front of NB Liquor.

Additionally, all By-Law amendments require Legislative updates to reflect the change from the *Municipalities Act* to the *Local Governance Act (2018)*.

Staff noted that no letters of objection have been received.

As per *Sect. 15(3)* and *subsection (a)* of the *Local Governance Act* states: Instead of being read in its entirety, a summary of a by-law may be read if; a notice has been given in a manner specified in section 70, twice a week for two weeks. The notice ran in the *St. Croix Courier* on October 23rd, 26th, 30th, and November 2nd. The By-Law is also available for review at Town Hall and on the official Town website.


