

BYLAW NO. 01-5
A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS,
SCOOTERS, AND INLINE SKATES WITHIN THE
TOWN OF ST. ANDREWS

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of St. Andrews deems it to be expedient for the peace, order and good government of the Town to regulate and control the area in the Town where skateboards, scooters, and inline skates are to be prohibited;

AND WHEREAS the Town Council is concerned about pedestrian safety and the protection of property;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of St. Andrews, a By-law, as follows:

1. In the area bordered by Queen Street, Elizabeth Street, Princess Royal Street and Water Street and including the St. Andrews Market Wharf, St. Andrews Market Square and the front entrance of all municipal buildings no person shall coast, ride on, slide or otherwise use a skateboard, scooter, or inline skates.
2. Any person who violates Section 1 of this By-law is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not to exceed the maximum fine that may be imposed for commission of an offence punishable under Part II of the Provincial Offences Procedures Act as a category C offence.
3. A person charged with an offence under Section 1 of this By-law may, on or before the date that a charge pertaining to the offence has been laid in Provincial Court, make a voluntary payment of \$50.00 to the Town as follows:
 - (a) In person at the Town of St. Andrews office, 212 Water Street; or
 - (b) By mail to the Town of St. Andrews, 212 Water Street, St. Andrews, NB, E5B 1B4; and

At which time the ticket or ticket number shall be surrendered to the TOWN and such payment shall be deemed payment in full.
