

BY-LAW #45
RESPECTING THE CLOSING OF PART
OF CARLETON AND PATRICK STREETS


The Town Council of St. Andrews, by authority vested in it under the Municipalities Act R.S.N.B. (Chapter M22) enacts as follows:


The sections of Town Streets named below being 60 feet in width shall be permanently closed and shall no longer be public thoroughfares.

(a) That portion of Patrick Street, from the eastern boundary of Prince of Wales Street in an easterly direction approximately 400 feet to lands now owned by the Province of New Brunswick.

(b) That portion of Carleton Street, from the southern boundary of Augustus Street in a southerly direction to its extremity at Patrick Street.
