

BY-LAW NO. 95-6

A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE
A PORTION OF CHAMPLAIN AVENUE

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of St. Andrews as follows:

1. All that portion of Champlain Avenue, so called, in the Town of St. Andrews, in the County of Charlotte, being thirty-three(33) feet in width, more or less, and extending from the northerly limits of King Street, so called, to the northeasterly sideline of lands of Charles J. Khoury, being the northwesterly line of lands of Lucinda Flemer being Lot 95-1 on a subdivision plan filed in the Charlotte County Registry Office on June 27, 1995 as No. 200,235, is hereby permanently stopped up and closed and shall no longer be a public thoroughfare.
