A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE DOUGLAS STREET EXTENSION

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Saint Andrews as follows:

- 1. All that portion of Douglas Street, in the Town of Saint Andrews, in the County of Charlotte, known as Douglas Street Extension, being fifty (50) feet in width, more or less, and extending from the southeasterly limits of Douglas Street, to the northwesterly limits of Princess Royal Street and crossing land conveyed by the Estate of Earl Thomas Caughey to David Michael Caughey by deed dated February 11, 1994 and recorded in the Charlotte County Registry Office in Book No. 537 at Page 486 on February 14, 1994 as No. 127542 is hereby permanently stopped up and closed and shall no longer be a public thoroughfare.
