# CURBSIDE COURTESY

- Makes the community safer.
- Encourages citizens to consider the well-being of others when using common spaces/streets/parks.





## CONTAINER:

- means a water tight, galvanized metal or plastic garbage 'container' with a maximum capacity of 32 cu ft

And not less than 2 cubic feet with a fitted lid and suitable handles weighing not more than 50 pounds when full.

- or  
an opaque polyethylene plastic garbage bag of 1.5 mil. thickness, with a maximum capacity of 8 cu. ft and not less than 2 cubic feet.

## GARBAGE:

- means refuse and other discarded matter produced within a dwelling house on a regular basis.
- It shall also mean leaves, grass cuttings, provided that they are in proper containers not to exceed 50 pounds per container





## WASTE:

- means discarded building materials such as lumber and construction materials used for erection, alteration, demolition or repair of buildings or structure,
- residue from trees such as roots, stumps, trunks and branches larger than 3 inches in diameter, discarded metals, piping, fencing, tools, swimming pools, automobiles, snowmobiles, motorcycles, bicycles or related parts,
- stones, rocks, sand, gravel, manure, the remains or carcasses of any dead animals, or any other discarded material other than garbage, petroleum products, radio-active or any other hazardous wastes

# GARBAGE ETIQUETTE



- Not more than 10 CONTAINERS of GARBAGE will be collected at any one DWELLING HOUSE on any collection day.
- CONTAINERS shall be placed by the occupant in front of the dwelling HOUSE just off the travelled portion of the street so as not to interfere with traffic



- Dwelling GARBAGE is NOT to remain upon property for period exceeding ten days without placing the contents for collection.

# TIMING IS EVERYTHING!

CONTAINERS to be placed curbside by the occupant of the dwelling house for collection:

- after 8:00 pm the night before collection
- before 7:00 am on the day of collection







## EMPTY CONTAINERS AND ANY MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED:

- To be removed by the occupant by 8:00 pm on the day of collection.

# WHERE TO PLACE CONTAINERS

- CONTAINERS shall be placed by the occupant in front of his DWELLING HOUSE just off the traveled portion of the street so as not to interfere with traffic,



# KEEP IT TIDY !

- No person shall throw, dump, place or deposit, or cause to be thrown, dumped, placed or deposited any GARBAGE or WASTE on any . . .

street, road, sidewalk, square, lane; alley, culvert, ditch, drain, sewer, wharf, beach or shore, or anywhere within the TOWN
