## Market Wharf 2020 Summer Season

Updated 26 May 2020

The Summer Season has begun at Market Wharf. The Wharf is open to the public for pedestrian traffic only. Covid-19 rules apply with minimum 6 feet / 2-meter distancing between people not in your immediate “bubble”.

Vehicle traffic is limited to authorized traffic only. Fisheries and Aquaculture workers are permitted. Other Wharf Access Permit holders are permitted vehicle access to the Wharf by appointment only. ### How it Works for 2020

1. 2. Fill out an application and submit it by email or in person to Town Hall.
3. Completed applications will be reviewed, and a new for 2020, a Wharf Access Permit with **your personal Tender Tag number will be issued** to successful applicants. Successful applicants will be in good standing and not in arrears with the Town for any reason.
4. **Before bringing your tender to the Wharf, visit the Wharfinger, show your Access Permit** and be issued your numbered Tender Tag for 2020.
5. Affix your Tag to your Tender as directed by Wharf staff and you are good to start enjoying the boating season using the Wharf.
6. If you need to bring equipment or supplies by vehicle, please make a reservation with Wharf staff for a time suitable to you.

#### *Please note:*

Vessel left on the Tender Jetty or Wharf Docks without properly displaying a 2020 Wharf Access Tag will be removed at the owner's risk and expense.

The Wharf staff are working to make the 2020 Summer Season an enjoyable experience in these uncertain times. Please join with us as we navigate the uncharted world of living safely with Covid-19.
