By-Law 19-06 Tourism Accommodation Levy Town of Saint Andrews

May 1, 2020

In March 2019, the Government of New Brunswick adopted enabling legislation to provide authority under the *Local Governance Act* to permit municipalities to establish and collect a Tourism Accommodation Levy.

The Tourism Accommodation Levy is set at 3% of the base accommodation price (not ancillary fees) of Tourism Accommodations within the Town of Saint Andrews.

By-Law 19-06, A By-Law Related to a Tourism Accommodation Levy in the Town of Saint Andrews was read for a third time on March 30th, 2020 and enacted as of May 1st, 2020. All hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts, Airbnb's, cottages, resorts, campgrounds, and other short-term rental properties will be subject to this Levy and must register with the Town of Saint Andrews by June 1, 2020. A short-term rental refers to any premises operated to provide, for remuneration, temporary accommodations for the public for a continuous period not exceeding 31 days. A copy of By-Law 19-06 Tourism Accommodation Levy has been provided for your reference.

This letter is to acknowledgement that the Tourism Accommodation Levy By-Law 19-06 has been enacted. Agents of accommodation businesses are hereby given notice that a 3% Levy is to now be collected on all accommodations within the Town of Saint Andrews.
