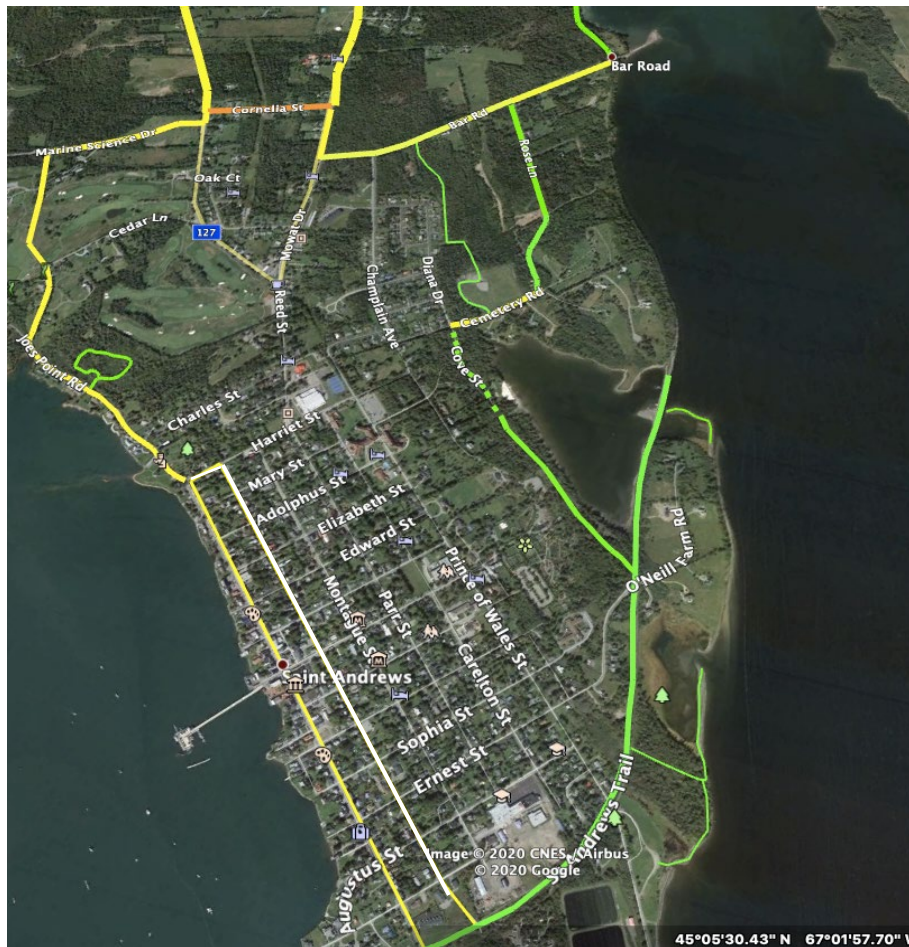

A. OPENING OF THE PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION

The Town of Saint Andrews is providing the community with an opportunity to provide feedback and comments on the Proposed Coastal Link Trail Route. The Coastal Link Trail is an initiative to connect a trail system in Maine, USA to the Trans Canada Trail System that starts in Saint John, NB. A regional group is working towards the completion of this and they are asking the Council to support an official segment within the municipal limits. As part of the public process, the Town of Saint Andrews is hosting a Public Information Session on the Coastal Link Trail proposal. A presentation will be made by Coastal Link Trail Organization on the proposed route.



- Yellow lines are public roads
- Green lines are trails

The proposed route would follow:

- Coming up the 127 from Bayside;
- Turn down Marine Science Drive;
- Go to Brandy Cove Road, entrance to the new golf course;
- Cross over stopped up section of the road;
- Through Joe's Point Road onto Water St;
- Catch the Van Horne Trail on Water St. and follow through to Bar Rd.
- At this point, cross the Bar Rd. onto the old railway line that works its way towards Harkness Rd.
