NOTICE OF THIRD READING BY TITLE OF BY-LAW 21-04, A BY-LAW RESPECTING ENCROACHMENT UPON PUBLIC SPACES IN THE TOWN OF SAINT ANDREWS

Local Governance Act Authorization Section 15(3)

Instead of being read in its entirety, a summary of a By-Law may be read if:

- (a) *A notice has been given in a manner specified in Section 70, twice a week for two weeks that,*
 - (i) *Describes the proposed By-Law by title and generally by subject matter.*
 - (ii) *States that the proposed By-Law may be examined*
 - (A) *In the office of the clerk during regular office hours, and*
 - (B) *On the local government's website, if the local government has posted it on its website.*
- (b) *At least 14 days have elapsed between the day on which the notice is first given and the day on which the By-Law is to be read for the third time by title; and*
- (c) *No member of Council objects.*

DESCRIPTION OF BY-LAW

By-Law 21-04, A By-Law Respecting Encroachment Upon Public Spaces in the Town of Saint Andrews establishes a procedure in which a person or business can construct or maintain a structure or sign on public spaces owned by the Town of Saint Andrews or on a public right-of-way.
