Re: Canada Day Weekend Processes

The Town of Saint Andrews would like to notify residents and visitors of important information regarding the Canada Day weekend.

Thursday, June 30th, 2022

- The regular Saint Andrews Thursday Farmers' Market will be moving from Market Square to King Street. King Street will be closed from 7:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. from Water Street to Queen Street. Please do not park your vehicles on this section of the street after 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 29th, 2022.
- Please note that Market Square will be closed to vehicular traffic on Thursday, June 30th, 2022, beginning at 8:00 a.m. to Saturday, July 2nd, 2022, until early afternoon. Public Works will be setting up seating and a stage for the Canada Day events.

Friday, July 1st, 2022, Canada Day

- Celebrations will be taking place from 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Water Street will be **CLOSED** to vehicular traffic from 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. from Edward Street to Frederick Street AND King Street will also be **CLOSED** to vehicular traffic from Water Street to Queen Street.
- Please do not park on Water Street between Edward Street to Frederick Street and King Street from Water Street to Queen Street after 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 30th, 2022.

Saturday, July 2nd, 2022

- Public Works will be cleaning up Market Square and Water Street early on Saturday morning. They will be using equipment including loaders, trucks, and leaf blowers. Please be aware that this cleaning process will be taking place.
