AMENDMENT MP20-02-01 TO TOWN OF SAINT ANDREWS SECONDARY MUNICIPAL PLAN MP20-02 FOR PID 01320035 AND 15054893 AT 256 AND 260 WATER STREET FOR BRIDLE PATH INTERNATIONAL INC.

The Council of the Town of Saint Andrews, in compliance with *Section 111 of the Community Planning Act of the Province of New Brunswick*, intends to hold a Public Hearing of objections and/or Comments under the proposed **Amendment MP20-02-01 to the Town of Saint Andrews Secondary Municipal Plan MP20-02 for PID 01320035 and 15054893 at 256 and 260 Water Street for Bridle Path International Inc.**

Bridle Path International Inc. are seeking an amendment to allow for a development of 12.2 m four-storey 36-unit mixed-use commercial and residential apartment complex. They are seeking an exemption to the Secondary Municipal Plan MP20-02 under Historical Business District Section 2.1.2.6 (a), (b), and (c).
