POLICY P-24-04 DERELICT VEHICLES TOWN OF SAINT ANDREWS

1. Policy Statement

1.1. The Town of Saint Andrews, under the Dangerous or Unsightly Premises By-Law identifies derelict vehicles as a potential issue in the community that shall be dealt with through By-Law Enforcement. To identify vehicles as derelict, this policy outlines the terms for designating a vehicle as derelict.

2. Derelict Vehicle

- 2.1. "Derelict vehicle" means a motor vehicle, tractor, trailer, truck, camper, boat, motorcycle, demolition endurance vehicle, motorized snow vehicle, mechanical equipment, machinery or parts thereof, or any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power or any part thereof, that is not in an operating condition and is discarded, rusted, deflated tires, wrecked or partly wrecked, or is dismantled or partly dismantled but does not include agricultural equipment.
- 2.2. Vehicles that are licenced or unlicensed which are inoperative, unused, discarded, in disrepair, or which have deteriorated or have parts removed, including but not limited to tires, glass, motors, windshields, or windows which prevent their proper functioning.
- 2.3. No person shall park, abandon or leave, a derelict vehicle on private or public property with or without consent of the owner of the property.
- 2.4. No owner, occupant, or person in charge or control of private or public property shall keep or allow to be kept, any derelict vehicle on the property.

3. Exemptions

- 3.1. The derelict vehicle is wholly contained within a lawfully existing structure on the property.
- 3.2. One derelict vehicle is allowed in the rear yard of a property if covered with an appropriate cover designed for that purpose or in a rear yard which is completely fenced in with a solid fence with a minimum height of six (6) feet.

3.3. The vehicle is offered or exposed for sale on the property for not more than sixty (60) days in one (1) year, and no more than one (1) vehicle is offered or exposed for sale at any one (1) time.

4. Enforcement

4.1. This Policy supports the Dangerous and Unsightly Premises By-Law of the Town of Saint Andrews and is enforced by the By-Law Enforcement Officer.
